## Pay-Per-Bag Plastics Recycling

Simply purchase a recycling bag, fill it with your clean recyclables, and drop it off at one of our drop-off locations

1. Cost: \$3.00 per 40 gallon bag
2. Please tie your bag with a simple bow tie – it makes sorting much easier!
3. Please don't cut up plastic as we sort it by type before baling & shipping

### Acceptable Material:

Plastic bottles and containers #1-#7

1. PET: soda bottles, water bottles
2. HDPE: milk bottles, detergent bottles, spray bottles, shampoo and lotion...
3. PVC: bottles, containers. No pipe
4. LDPE: squeezable bottles, etc.
5. PP: medicine bottles, drinking straws, ketchup bottles, dairy tubs, etc.
6. PS: compact disc jackets, tableware, containers, solo cups. No styrofoam.
7. Other: reusable water bottles, rigid containers and jars.

### We do not accept the following:

1. No Styrofoam! We cannot recycle Styrofoam.
2. No plastic bags or plastic film - black trash bags, pet food bags, tarps, etc.
3. No cassette tapes, 8 track tapes.
4. No PVC pipe
5. No Hazardous materials

## Free Drop Off at Swink:

- Cardboard – all types
- Cartons – milk and juice cartons
- Metals: aluminum, steel, tin cans, washers, dryers, (no freon)
- Paper: news, office, shredded, mags.
- Kitty Litter Buckets
- 5- Gallon Buckets
- Cattle Supplement Tubs
- Triple-rinsed ag chemical jugs
- Glass bottles, jars, all colors
- Microwave ovens

## Cardboard

Cardboard is the single largest component of waste from businesses going to our landfill and it is one of the easiest items to recycle. So don't throw it in the dump – recycle it!

1. Break down and flatten your cardboard, corrugated cardboard or paper-board (cereal boxes, etc) and stack in an intact box.
2. Do not include any cardboard contaminated with oil, grease, food or chemicals.
3. Bring your cardboard to one of our drop-off locations.
4. We would be happy to come and pick up cardboard at your place of business for a minimal fee.

## Electronics

Electronics Recycling is available at the Swink Sugar Factory location only. We are partnering with Electronic Recyclers International to ethically recycle your electronics while providing meaningful jobs in Colorado.

### Recycling fees:

#### No charge:

computer towers\*, laptops, servers, cell phones, ink cartridges, microwaves

#### 20 cents/Lb:

general E-waste: printers, AV equipment, IT components, scanners, small appliances..

#### 25 cents/foot:

fluorescent lights

#### 38 cents/lb: flat screen TVs, monitors

#### 48 cents/lb:

computer monitors, TV's

#### 50 cents each for CFL bulbs

#### \$1 / lb: Alkali batteries

Other batteries: check with us

\* For data destruction, take your computer to Triad Computer Systems at 1321 E 3<sup>rd</sup> in La Junta. They will certifiably erase all personal data and then recycle your computer through Clean Valley.

## Paint

Recycle your leftover paint!  
Free drop-off. Lids need to be secure and original labels on. Recycled paint will be repurposed and sold for a small fee.
